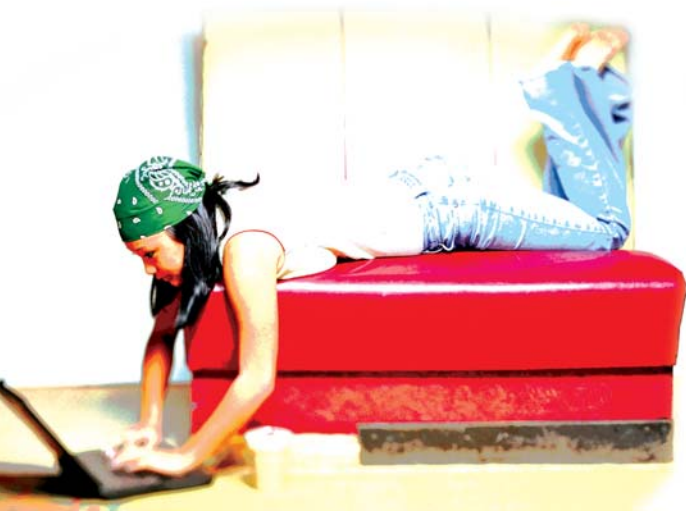


Short Story Contest for young writers ages 12 to 18

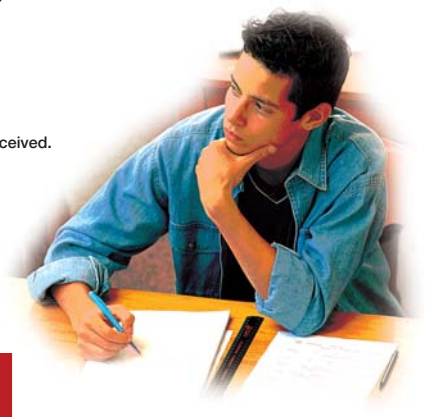
